GENERAL DELEGATE CONDUCT

1. Attire

- Delegates are expected to be dressed in Western Formal Attire for the duration of the Conference.
 - Full sleeve formal shirts paired with formal pants are allowed. Ties, blazers or full suits are not mandatory, but are recommended.
 - Jeans and sneakers are absolutely prohibited.
 - Should one choose to wear a skirt, it must be of appropriate length (knee-length).
 - Delegates of the AIPPM are permitted to wear formal Indian traditional attire. (Lehengas and lungis will not be considered appropriate formal attire for the conference. You may wear sandals if you are a part of AIPPM)
 - Delegates in violation of the attire policy will not be allowed, and will be informed to return in appropriate attire to be allowed entry. The Security Team will have the final say in such matters pertaining to attire.
- Delegates are not permitted to change their dress for socials.

2. Decorum

- In order to respect fellow Delegates, all members of the committee are to maintain decorum during the Conference.
- GWHMUN will not tolerate any instances of verbal or physical harassment, or discrimination based on race, gender, sexual orientation, caste, creed, religion, nationality, or physical features, both within and outside of the committee.
- If the secretariat deems it necessary, offenders may be barred from the remainder of the conference.
- Offences may also be escalated to the Head Delegate, Faculty Advisor, or respective head of the delegate's institution on a case-by-case basis.
- The conference follows a strict zero-tolerance policy to narcotics, alcohol, vape pens, or substances of any kind. Periodic inspections for the same will be conducted by security members.
- Delegates found violating this policy will be prohibited from further Committee Sessions and will be reported to the Faculty Advisor of their respective institution.

3. Guidelines for delegates

- Delegates are NOT permitted to visit other committees except the ones they have been allotted to, unless they are delegates of the IPC.
- Delegates are requested to respect the school property, including, but not limited to, tables, chairs, walls etc. Any damages will be noted by the secretariat, and fines will be levied respectively.
- Delegates are required to carry their School ID cards with them, or they will not be allowed to enter their respective committee.
- Delegates will be expected to wear the ID cards provided to them by the Registrations Team at all times during the conference.
- The SOCIALS event will be held at the exact timings of the schedule. No extensions of any sort.
- Any form of adulteration with water is strictly prohibited. Delegates will NOT be allowed to carry water bottles containing liquids into the Socials Venue.
- Delegates are expected to comply with all instructions provided by organizing members and security throughout the MUN.
- Delegates are recommended to bring cash to the conference to buy from the food stalls.
- If a delegate wishes to bring their own food, *or* if a delegate has medication, they are to email the Secretariat at gwhmun@greenwoodhigh.edu.in with the same information.

Laptops are allowed. Delegates may carry mobile phones but there are only 2 designated areas where they may use it. At the main gate and reception. Under no circumstances should it be used in corridors and committee rooms.
